### MYLC IN DC

Ten members of the Mayor's Youth Leadership Council – along with Mayor Jurado and Marketing & Communications Officer Laurie Hayes – were in Washington, DC, last week, participating in the Close Up Foundation Program. One of the highlights was meeting with Congressman Ross Spano on Capitol Hill to discuss issues related to our area. ### TTPD OFFICER TO SERVE AS REGION 5 PRESIDENT OF FAHN

Corporal Joseph Kinlaw has been nominated and elected to serve as Region 5 president of the Florida Association Of Hostage Negotiators (FAHN), an association of more than 500 Florida law enforcement, mental health, criminal justice and corrections professionals. (Region 5 covers Hillsborough, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk and Sumter Counties.) FAHN members are dedicated to crisis intervention in a variety of situations, which require a highly skilled negotiator to bring about a successful resolution. Cpl. Kinlaw will work to facilitate training within our region to help keep negotiators in FAHN current with the skills necessary to effectively deal with these types of situations. ## JOINT FIRST RESPONDER ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING THIS WEEK



The City of Temple Terrace Police and Fire Departments will team up to conduct the first-ever joint training exercises focusing on active shooter incident response / management and Mass Casualty Response. The training will involve structured scenarios to allow first responders to hone their skills in relation to crisis response, planning and procedures and will help assure a coordinated, timely and effective response and recovery in the event of an actual incident in the City. To assist with the safety of our Firefighter/Paramedics when responding to such an incident, each fire apparatus used by the City is now equipped with Ballistic Vests, Helmets and Medical Go Bags. The exercises will take place from 9 a.m. until 6 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday, on the Florida College Campus.

## REC COMPLEX RENOVATIONS COMPLETE (RIBBON-CUTTING THIS FRIDAY)

The City will officially unveil the new, improved Family Recreation Complex this week. The nearly year-long renovation included the construction of a new fitness center, improvements to outdoor basketball courts and the gymnastics center, revamped pool locker rooms, offices, classrooms and upgrades to the lobby of the building. The public is invited to a ribbon cutting ceremony at 9 a.m. Friday, June 21, on the grounds of the Complex, 6610 Whiteway Dr.

In addition to the structural upgrades, a snack bar/coffee shop also was added to the Complex. Now open, the Focus Cafe is staffed by students in the Transition program at Focus Academy, a charter school for special needs students ages 14 to 22 years located in Temple Terrace. In addition to providing soft drinks, coffee and other menu items to patrons and staff, the Cafe provides the students with real world job experience. They plan to expand their offerings this summer to include smoothies and ice cream. Be sure and stop by to see the improvements – and support the Focus Academy students.
