### PHASE I OF GOVERNOR'S RECOVERY PLAN BEGAN TODAY

Governor DeSantis' "Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step." plan went into at 12:01am this morning. Among the highlights of the executive order:

- Restaurants may offer outdoor seating with 6 feet between tables and indoor seating at 25% capacity
- Retail can operate at 25% of indoor capacity
- No change from previous orders regarding bars, gyms, and personal services such as hair salons
- Schools remain distance learning
- Visits to senior living facilities are prohibited
- Elective surgeries can resume

## OMAR K. LIGHTFOOT DIES

Longtime resident Omar Kenneth Lightfoot Jr., 91, whose family donated the land on which the Omar K. Lightfoot Center was built, passed away April 17. A Korean War veteran, Lightfoot was the owner/president of Ken Lightfoot Realty, Inc. for over 60 years. He also served as president of the Temple Terrace Optimist Club, Rotary Club and Temple Terrace Chamber of Commerce, which named him Citizen of the Year. Lightfoot served on the Exchange Bank of Temple Terrace Board of Directors and was a charter member of the Temple Terrace Golf & Country Club. For the last 48 years, he was instrumental in the growth and development of University Community Hospital, now AdventHealth Tampa. He continued serving on the AdventHealth Carrollwood Board of Directors until his death.
