## WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH

March is Women's History Month and Temple Terrace continues to celebrate the strong women to whom the City owes its beginnings. Maud Fowler (1874-1941) was one of the foremost female real estate operators in the country when she moved her headquarters to Temple Terrace in 1920 to oversee a project here. After the incorporation of Temple Terrace, Fowler served first as City Commissioner and then as the first Vice Mayor. Maud's son, Cody Fowler, who served as City Attorney and later Mayor, drafted the city charter to incorporate the city of Temple Terrace. Fowler Ave. is named in the family's honor. Fowler, who was described in the Tampa Bay Times archives as an "imposing 6-foot tall woman with a bankroll and plenty of business acumen," is shown here as the lone female among a group of officers and developers of the City.
