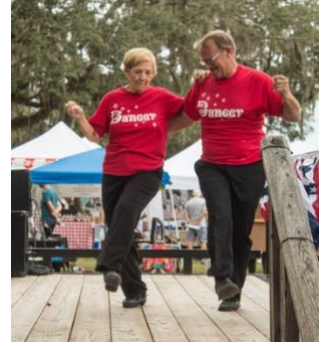






### 48<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ARTS & CRAFTS FESTIVAL IN THE BOOKS
