Students in our After School Program enjoyed a special visit from the Tampa Bay Lightning Street Team last week. The children were taught some of the basics of street hockey through various skills stations which culminated in a timed scrimmage. The drills consisted of learning how to stick handle the ball, angle a bank pass and pass and shoot. The instruction was provided by members of the Street Team and former Lightning player and 2009 Stanley Cup Champion Goaltender Mathieu Garon. Each student received a Lightning-logged street hockey stick and ball to take home as well as an autographed Mathieu Garon player card.

The Lightning also donated a complete set of street hockey gear to the After School Program, including 38 sticks, 2 goal nets, a case of 38 balls and 38 reversible Lightning pinnies. A huge thank you to the Tampa Bay Lightning for offering this FREE activity and equipment for our children!

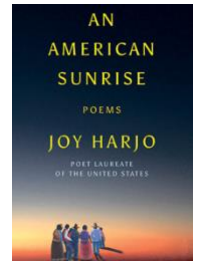
VETERANS DAY REMINDER
