HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

Each year, Americans observe National Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15 by celebrating the histories, cultures and contributions of people whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America. Approximately 20% of Temple Terrace residents identified as being Hispanic or Latino in the US census. The Temple Terrace Public Library has many resources to explore Hispanic culture and history, including a themed *I Spy* game for the whole family. DISASTER PLANNING

A partnership between Move the World Films, Inc. and the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council has resulted in a documentary about people who have lost everything to natural disasters in Florida, Oklahoma and California. A free screening of the "Last House Standing" is available to stream through September 24. The director of the film is George Siegal, a former weatherman and TV reporter.

Siegel explores the fact that most people think catastrophic destruction will never happen to them – and have no idea if their insurance will actually get them whole again. With more than a month left in this hurricane season, "Last House Standing" is a wake-up call to take control of one's destiny and do whatever is needed to protect homes and lives.
