Appointment to the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple Terrace are accepting applications from citizens interested in being considered for appointment to the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission.

The regular meetings of the Planning Commission are held on the second Monday of each month at 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Planning Commission, 18th Floor, 601 E. Kennedy Boulevard, Tampa. Members are appointed by each local government in the County for a four-year term; Temple Terrace has one appointee. The City of Temple Terrace appointee serves without remuneration, and financial disclosure is required.

The Planning Commission and its staff serve as agents within the community to promote and coordinate the involvement of all people in comprehensive long-range planning, growth management, transportation, and environmental protection. The Planning Commission makes recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners, the Tampa City Council, the Plant City Commission, and the Temple Terrace City Council regarding land use, community planning, capital improvements, urban design, and other comprehensive issues.

Equal consideration will be given to persons submitting applications and persons recommended by members of the City Council.
