### **APPOINTMENT TO THE COMMUNITY ACTION BOARD**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple Terrace are accepting applications from citizens interested in being considered to serve as the City's representative on the twenty-one-member Hillsborough County Community Action Board.

The Community Action Board serves Hillsborough County's low-income residents and communities by assisting Hillsborough County's Social Services department in the development and implementation of programs that empower individuals and families to achieve self-sufficiency. These programs are funded by the Community Services Block Grant.

The Community Action Board is a volunteer advisory board that consists of 21 members from three different sectors throughout Hillsborough County. Low-income residents, elected officials or their representative, and members from public/private organizations make up the three sectors. Each sector contains seven members. The term of the appointment is three years. Meetings are monthly on the second Wednesday from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at 2103 N. Rome Avenue, Tampa, FL 33607.
