PERMIT GUIDELINES

Conditions, requirements and instructions to excavate, dig, construct or install structures within a public right-of-way or easement:

1. All new facilities installed within any public right-of-way require that a permit application and three (3) copies of the construction plan be submitted to the City of Temple Terrace a minimum of ten (10) days in advance of beginning work.
2. The permit will not be effective and work cannot proceed unless the Engineering Division is notified at **(813) 506-6560** not less than forty-eight (48) hours, nor more than five (5) working days prior to construction. The notification requirement is waived when it is established that the excavation work is of emergency nature. Call SUNSHINE STATE ONE CALL, 1-800-432-4770.
3. For scheduled construction, the contractor must notify SUNSHINE STATE ONE CALL, 1-800-432-4770, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to starting work.
4. All areas disturbed during construction must be restored to their original condition.
5. During construction, all required safety devices must be utilized (cones, barricades, flashers, etc.).
6. Failure or neglect on the part of the applicant to carry out all work in conformance with the conditions set forth in the permit shall be grounds for revocation of the permit by the City of Temple Terrace.
7. Permittee shall submit the permit application and plans to the Engineering Division, 11210 North 53rd Street, Temple Terrace, FL 33617.
