## **Apartment Fire Displaces Four Families, No Injuries**

**Date of Incident:** Aug. 8, 2006

**Location:** Terrace Club Apts., 7305 Heritage Hills Dr.

**Dispatch Time:** 3:36 a.m.

**Cause:** Under Investigation

**Injuries:** None

**Preliminary Damage Estimate:** \$300,000 to \$400,000

**Details:** The Temple Terrace Fire Department responded to a fire at Terrace Club Apts. at 3:36 a.m. A four-unit building was engulfed in flames. Firefighters were able to extinguish the fire by around 4 a.m. They were assisted by Hillsborough County Fire Rescue. There were no injuries, but four families were displaced. The American Red Cross is working with the families to find them temporary shelter. Damage to the apartment building is estimated at \$300,000 to \$400,000. The cause of the fire is unknown and remains under investigation. The state Fire Marshal's office will assist in that investigation.
