Benefits

The City of Temple Terrace provides the following benefits:

Uniforms

If a volunteer worker is in an area where a uniform is required, one will be provided.

City Awards Program

Volunteers who present ideas or suggestions to improve methods and working conditions may be eligible to participate in the City's "Excellence in City Government Awards Program".

Recreation Center Privileges

Volunteers will have free access to the amenities at City recreational facilities.

Credit Union

Volunteers may have membership in the Florida Central Credit Union.

Liability Insurance

Volunteers are covered under the City's liability to third parties insurance policies.

Worker's Compensation

Volunteers injured while performing assigned duties are covered by worker's compensation to the same extent as employees.
