CITY OFFICES TO CLOSE MONDAY, JULY 5 FOR HOLIDAY

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (6/24/10) – Independence Day falls on Sunday this year, so Temple Terrace City Hall and other government offices will be closed Monday, **July 5, 2010** in recognition of the national holiday.

There will be no residential garbage collection on Monday, July 5. Commercial garbage collection will not be affected.

The Temple Terrace Public Library will be closed July 3, 4 and 5. The library will close early on July 2 (at 1 p.m.)

The Family Recreation Complex will be open July 5 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Don't forget the City's ***Independence Day Parade*** on Saturday, July 3 from 10 a.m. to noon.

The parade will start at the corner of Whiteway Drive and Gillette Avenue. The parade will head south on Gillette, west on Druid Hills, then south on Ridgedale Road to the Ridgedale Sports Complex near Temple Terrace Elementary School.

Fireworks will light up the sky at 9:15 p.m. and can be viewed from the first fairway of the Temple Terrace golf course, between Belle Terre and Woodmont avenues. Lawn chairs and blankets are OK, but please do not bring personal fireworks of any kind to the golf course!

Free parking is available at Terrace Plaza (corner of Bullard Parkway and 56th Street).
