NEW TEMPLE TERRACE CITY COUNCIL TO BE SWORN IN

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (11/9/10) – A new *Temple Terrace City Council* will be sworn in during the council's regularly scheduled Tuesday night meeting, Nov. 16, 2010, in Temple Terrace City Hall.

Initially, four candidates were vying for three open seats on the council. However, one candidate withdrew before the Nov. 2 general election. As a result, the other three candidates will be seated as prescribed under Florida law, according to the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections Office.

Council members who will be sworn in Nov. 16 are incumbent **Alison Fernandez**, who was first elected in 2006; former Temple Terrace police officer **Bob Boss**; and construction consultant **David Pogorilich**.

They will join Mayor Joe Affronti and current council members Mary Jane Neale and Ron Govin.

The council meeting will begin at 6 p.m. Following council business and a swearing-in ceremony, a reception will take place at Temple Terrace Public Works, 11210 N. 53rd St.

Temple Terrace residents and guests are invited to come out and meet the new City Council members, as well as offering warm wishes to outgoing council members Ken Halloway and Mark Knapp.

City Council members are elected at-large, and the election is nonpartisan. Council members serve four-year terms.
