TEMPLE TERRACE CELEBRATES 'NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK'

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (4/1/11) – The Temple Terrace Public Library will join libraries across the country this month in celebrating *National Library Week* (April 10-16, 2011).

First sponsored in 1958, National Library Week is an observance sponsored by the American Library Association – and libraries across the country – each April. It is a time to celebrate the contributions of libraries and librarians, and to promote library use and support.

The Temple Terrace City Council will issue a proclamation April 5 thanking library workers and encouraging everyone in the community to visit the Temple Terrace Public Library and take advantage of its many resources.

Throughout National Library Week, the Temple Terrace Public Library will be celebrating with a variety of special events and programming:

- * Monday, April 11 at 2 p.m. – Kickoff celebration and special award ceremony honoring retired library director Mary Satterwhite
- * Tuesday, April 12 at 2 p.m. – Introduction to *Life Story Writing*
- * Tuesday, April 12 at 6:30 p.m. – Performance by the *Temple Terrace Highlanders* (bagpipe band)
- * Saturday, April 16 at 1 p.m. – Thomas the Tank Engine: Crafts, games and stories. Snacks provided by the Junior Woman's Club of Temple Terrace.

Drawings for prizes will be held throughout the week, including Book Nook gift certificates and library tote bags. Prize winners will be selected from among those who fill out and return a comment card during the week. You do not have to be present to win, and winners will be notified by telephone.
