TEMPLE TERRACE TO CELEBRATE VETERANS DAY

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (11/1/11) – The City of Temple Terrace will host a special program Friday, Nov. 11, 2011 to honor area military veterans for *Veterans Day 2011*.

The Veterans Day program will be 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Omar K. Lightfoot Recreation Center, 10901 N. 56th St., Temple Terrace. It is Temple Terrace's way of saying "thank you" to the men and women who have served in America's armed forces. All area veterans and their families are invited to attend.

Temple Terrace Mayor Joe Affronti will be this year's featured speaker. There will be musical performances and other special guests and dignitaries.

The King High Naval Junior ROTC will act as color guard, and Pastor Al Wolever of the Riverhills Church of God will offer the invocation. Retired U.S. Army Lt. Col. Dave Froberg will offer closing remarks.

The Temple Terrace Highlanders pipe and drum band will perform several patriotic songs.

Following the ceremony, there will be free refreshments with hot dogs, chips and drinks provided by the Greater Temple Terrace Chamber of Commerce. Free cupcakes also will be served, courtesy of Sweetbay Supermarket.

The event is hosted by the Temple Terrace Leisure Services Department.
