“Temple Terrace is built around a golf course, and quite a few of the residents have golf carts. It’s a way to get more community involvement,” said Cori Collins, recreation supervisor for the Temple Terrace Parks and Recreation Department.

The event is Saturday, Dec. 8, 2007 at Riverhills Park, 329 S. Riverhills Drive. The event runs 5:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. There will be caroling, hayrides, a bonfire, food and more. The Lighted Golf Cart Parade will start at 7:30 p.m.

There is no entry fee. However, everyone who wishes to participate is encouraged to attend a workshop for cart decorating and lighting on Saturday, Dec. 1, 2007 at 10 a.m. at the Family Recreation Complex, 6610 E. Whiteway Drive.

All parade participants should pre-register their golf carts by Dec. 4, 2007.
