POLICE SEEK SUSPECT IN CREDIT UNION ROBBERY

(TEMPLE TERRACE, FL – 10/27/10) – Police are asking for the public's assistance in finding a man who robbed a federal credit union in Temple Terrace on Tuesday, Oct. 26.

The robbery occurred at 4:19 p.m. at the GTE Federal Credit Union, 9380 N. 56th St., in Temple Terrace.

According to police, the man entered the credit union, displayed a note to the teller demanding money, and left the building westbound on foot after obtaining an undisclosed amount of cash. The man did not display a weapon, and no getaway vehicle was seen, police said. No one was injured in the incident.

Police described the robber as a white male in his 20s or 30s, 5-ft. 10-inches to 6-ft. tall, with a slender to medium build. He was light-skinned with short or shaved reddish, or light-colored, hair. He was wearing a plaid, long-sleeve, red-and-white, button-down shirt with matching long shorts; black-and-white sneakers; and a light-brown, designer-style cap.

The suspect also was carrying a light-brown, designer-style handbag that appeared to match his cap.
